

Debut of the PowerWave

If you are looking for the latest in hotel in-room technology, check out the PowerWave, a single HDMI cable solution that guestLINK (Booth 5C1-03) is introducing to Asia for the first time.

Hotel guests can now plug in their digi-cam, camcorder, laptop, iPad, iPhone, iPod, DVD player, MP3 player, game station and so on into the connectivity panel and view videos and photos, surf the Internet, work on presentations and check their e-mails on the TV set in the comfort of their room.

Says Rakshit Sehgal, director, Guestlynkxx Technology, Singapore, the company that is bringing in the product from the US: "This is a new CEC (consumer electronic control)-specified product which can be used to switch on a TV on standby mode and it will switch on automatically the device or devices that are connected."

Commenting on the response at FHA2010, Sehgal says: "We've had a couple of good responses." Units are on display in a number of mock-up rooms in a few hotels in Singapore. Available as a flush-mount or desktop unit the panels' selling price is around S\$400 per unit, with the actual unit price depending on the number of units purchased.
